

MEALS

- Breakfast and dinner at the hotel or camping ground, every morning breakfast will be served by local farmers in the event tent
- Lunch will be available at the airfield, attractive pricing level secured
- Trinks, water, snacks and light meals will be available for purchase on site
- No vouchers necessary to take part in the evening events

WLAN:

Unfortunately free WLAN cannot be provided at the airfield of Leutkirch/ Unterzeil, but the possibility to use the 3. generation UMTS standard (universal mobile telecommunications system) of the Telecom is given.

Vodafone will provide a service of the 4. generation of LTE standard (long term evolution) at the airfield.

The use of a mobile phone as a WLAN hot spot and making use of a data transmission via this path seems to be the most preferable path to be connected to the outside world.

The user is kindly asked to look after the necessary devices by himself.





6. General information about registration

- Registration of the teams will start from January 1st until May 31st, 2015
- Please only make use of the official registration form available for download at <u>www.jwm2015.com</u> in due time.
- Last day for entries to register is May31st, 2015
- To support registration of supporters as many as possible, we will accept supporters' registrations until July 31th, 2015, later registration can be done via the website <u>www.jwm2015.com</u> under privat sponsors or directly on-site during the event
- Early registration will enable us in providing the best possible preparation for your arrival and way through customs
- The registration fees only cover attendance of the competition by team manager, pilots, helpers and supporters
- Supporters are given the same rights and privileges as private sponsors registered prior to the event on the website
- The Teams from the various countries are highly requested to bring along their national anthem (USB stick) and their national flag with the size of 1,5 x 0,9 mtrs. (standard size)

Airfield access limitations:

- Spectators will be restricted from the active flying airfield so called flight line and pilots area. Their admission to the JWM competition will be free of charge
- The entrance to the airfield is free of charge
- The parking lots at the airfield are free of charge
- Arrival time of the teams is not limited once they are accomodated in Hotels, flats, ...
- Camping lots can be entered on Tuesday August 18th, 2015 earliest
- Camping lots have to be cleared on Sunday 30th, 2015 latest

Registration questions:

All communication with the organizers shall be performed through the team manager channel only via the dedicated mail address, all other questions will not be answered.

Training time:

- Training will be possible exclusively on Friday 21st and Saturday 22nd
- During the days before Friday there will be no training slots available, even if there will be no air traffic on the runway
- For each country training slots are assigned and communicated herewith. The time of the slots are depending from the number of pilots of each participating nation. For each pilot a training time of 12 minutes is considered.
- Within the country training slot each team may decide individually about the order of sequence and number of models simultaneously are operated in the air. A reasonable number of models coincidently operated should not be exceeded.
- Once the slot has to be interrupted caused by a take-off or landing of a real A/C the lost time will be added on top at the end of the slot



Once the slot has to be interrupted caused by heavy rain or thunder storm the training slot will be catched up next day depending on the remaining training time.

<u>Saturday, August 22nd, 2015</u>

After the training slots of the dedicated countries jet models weighting more than 25,0kg (take-off weight, wet) have to checked by means of an inspection flight.

Weight of the Jet Models:

In Germany a strict weight limitation of model airplanes is followed, which has to be in compliance with present regulations. The IJMC rules requested a dry weight of 20,0kg without any fuel, respectively 13,5kg for being accepted as a contestant.

If the A/C weight in <u>wet condition</u> (take-off weight) is exceeding a threshold of 25,0kg a local authorization is necessary to provide in a written and stamped format. The organizer is kindly asking the contestants to send the local authorization documentation one week in advance of the official start of the JWM in order to allow the organizer to register the respective models.

Latest Arrival time for entries:

Latest arrival point in time for entries is Saturday 22nd, 2015 at 12.00am sharp in time
Once the entry has arrived at the airfield a quick registration shall be performed



8. Transport of Model crates

The organization team has managed a general cargo company for model crates convey for a Door-to-Door shipping.

QCS (Quick Cargo Services) offers exclusively the transport of the model boxes from home up to the arrival at the airfield and the way back home as well as the way through customs. Each interested pilot is highly requested to get in touch with our focal point *Oliver Krautter* in Stuttgart (Germany) to discuss the terms and conditions of the transport. He will liase with one of his local agents in the various countries to organize your individual transport of the box towards Leutkirch.

Thanks to the on-site availability of the cargo company at the airfield upcoming questions or support requests from the clients can be solved very rapidly.

10. Accommodation and Excursions

Leutkirch tourism is proud to host the Jet World Masters as the venue of the World Championships for the Jet Model family. An exciting, breathtaking landscape of the german alps will surprise you. All around will be some nice castles and lakes for your wellbeing and having fun.

We intend to offer excursions in the local area around as well as day trips to the lake of Constanze. Upon guests interest we want to offer a bus trip to Munich for doing shopping or visiting local beer gardens. The orga team in conjunction with the city of Leutkirch tourism will exclusively offer to families free entrance tickets to the local open air swimming pool nearby Leutkirch.

Camping lots at the airfield:

- Roughly 250 camping lots opposite to the airfield will be offered for Pilots and guests ready to be booked for the complete time duration of the event
- One car with trailer or one mobile home are allowed to be parked on one lot
- The number of tents allowed to be positioned on one camping lot is depending from the size
- One camping lot is offering a size of roughly 10 x 10 mtrs
- The fee for booking one camping lot is 150,00€ plus 19% VAT which results in 178,50€ in total.
- The booking procedure have to be done by means of a template which will be found on the official homepage <u>www.jwm2015.com</u>
- Once the fee is recognized on the bank account the number of the camping lot will be provided accordingly (bank account see chapter 9)
- Camping lots are provided with power 220V with 1kVA max.
